

Location

The conference will be held at the Mission Inn Resort & Club at 10400 County Road 48, Howey-in-the-Hills, FL, 34737. The group room rate is \$155 per night. Single and double occupancy deluxe accommodations are available.

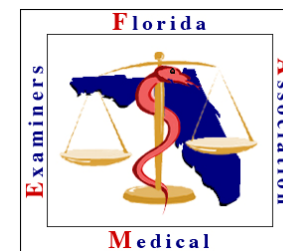
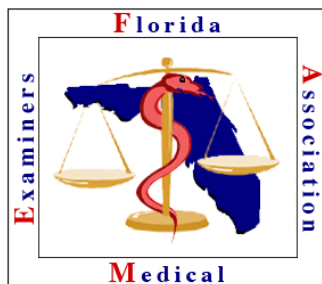
